

RECERTIFICATION POLICY for the JOURNEYMAN and MASTER PLUMBER

RECERTIFICATION

The two (2) options to renew a certification are:

Option 1

Renew using a computer exam recertification method. The computer exam recertification method is open book. The cost is \$40.

Option 2

Renew by obtaining Continuing Education Units (CEUs). Submit a total of 0.8 CEUs in any combination from the options below. The cost is \$30.

Attend eight (8) hours of continuing education through an NBOPE approved training seminar or course. Most local trade associations and training facilities offer these types of training courses. Contact the organizations directly for more information. UA Local 525 JATC, SMART Local 350 JATC, Plumbing, Heating, Cooling Contractors of Nevada (PHCC) and Associated Builders and Contractors of Nevada (ABC) are recognized training providers. A copy of a certification of completion must be submitted. 0.8 total CEUs.
Attend an in-person or online training course provided by IAPMO National, a Nevada-based IAPMO Chapter or one of the recognized training providers. A copy of each certification of completion must be submitted. 0.1 CEUs for each credit hour.
Attend an IAPMO Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC) development hearing or attend a local UPC code amendment committee developing and adopting local UPC amendments. Date and location of the hearing and/or committee attended, and a copy of sign-in sheet must be submitted. 0.1 CEUs for each credit hour.
Serve as a member of an IAPMO UPC committee or ASSE committee. Examples of approved committees include the following: UPC Workshop, UPC Answer and Analysis or UPC Standards. The date and location of the committee meeting attended, and a copy of your committee acceptance letter must be submitted. 0.1 CEUs for each credit hour.
Serve as an instructor of an IAPMO UPC course or recognized apprenticeship program. Details regarding date, topic, location and length of training must be submitted. 0.1 CEUs for each credit hour of instruction.

FINE PRINT

All CEUs must be earned during the valid period of your license or within three (3) years from the date of renewal. NBOPE reserves the right to request additional information for evaluation and issuing credit. NBOPE reserves the sole authority to determine acceptable training providers.
